## Swinging Country Rhythm

Bonnie Lou's recorded output in the 1950s occupied that small niche of early country rockers that eschewed the backwoods hillbilly boogie style and, instead, created something more unique.

Featuring a swinging country rhythm overlaid with horn solos and King's trademark handclap boosted offbeat, Bonnie's sound was often closer to Bill Haley than that of the other mid-west rockabillys.

Up until now, Bonnie Lou's classic King and Fraternity tracks from the 1950s have not been well-served by the reissue labels.

This compilation finally re-releases the very best of her best material, so if you like a steady diet of good 1950s country, pop, rockabilly, doowop and rock 'n' roll – or a pleasing mixture of all those elements - you're in for a treat.
